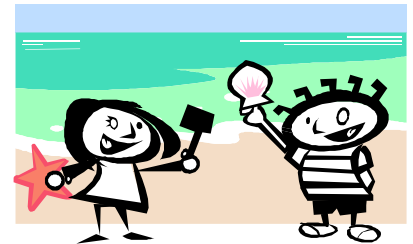
Dear Claire,

Wilchester Memories

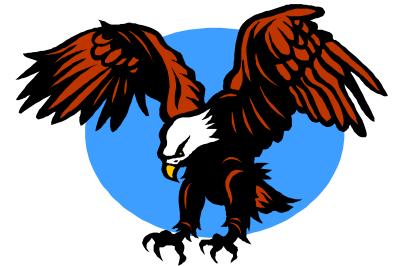
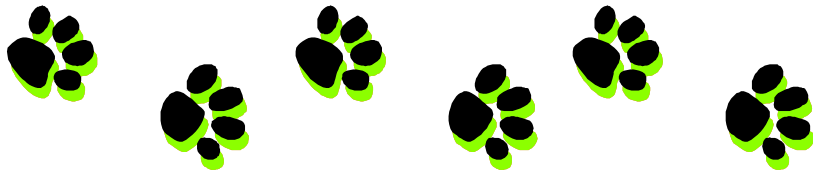
